# **BUVONAL** injection

For treatment of Theileriosis in cattle, including infection with East Coast Fever.

#### COMPOSITION:

Buvonal contains Buparvaquone 50 mg per ml. Buparvaquone is an analogue of Parvaquone, a hydroxynapthoquinone. It has a greater resistance to metabolic degradation than Parvaquone, resulting in much higher activity than Parvaquone.

### **INDICATIONS**

Buvonal injection is indicated for the treatment of Theileriosis in cattle. It is highly effective against Theileria species including the most significant Theilerial pathogens T. parva (parva), T. parva (lawrencei) T. parva (bovis), T. annulata, T. mutans and T. orientalis (sergenti).

## DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

Intramuscular injection into the neck muscles.

Calves and adult cattle: 1 ml per 20 kg bodyweight (2.5 mg/kg)

Bodyweight	Dose
100 kg	5 ml
150 kg	7.5 ml
200 kg	10 ml
250 kg	12.5 ml
300 kg	15 ml

More advanced cases may require 1 or more additional injections given at an interval of 2 to 3 days as clinically indicated.

## WITHDRAWAL PERIOD:

Meat: 42 days. Milk: 48 hours.

#### Storage:

Store between 2°c and 25°C. Protect from light.
Keep out of reach of children.
